General Navigation

Switching Orientation

- 1. Swipe your finger down from the top of the main screen to display the orientation switch buttons.
- 2. Select the desired button.

Note: The quick keys are configurable. These images are just representative.

ECG

Checking Paced Status

- 1. Tap the HR digital area or ECG waveform area to enter the **ECG** menu.
- 2. Set Paced to Yes or No.

Changing Lead

If **Change Lead** is configured in the quick keys area, tapping **Change Lead** changes the current first ECG lead waveform to the next ECG lead waveform that is available in sequential order.

RESP (Optional)

Enabling/Disabling the Resp Functionality

- 1. Press to enter the main menu.
- 2. Tap Parameter Setup.
- 3. Enable or disable Resp.

Setting NCM Alarm Delay

- 1. Tap the Resp digital area or Resp waveform area to enter the **Resp** menu.
- 2. Set NCM Alarm Delay.

Monitoring with BP10

Pairing a TM80 with a BP10

- 1. Press the MPAN key on the right panel of the BP10.
- 2. Press 🖲 to enter the main menu of the TM80.
- 3. Tap Wireless Modules → tap MPAN →select Connect to BP10 →select your desired device from the list of devices →tap Connect.

Unpairing via the TM80

- 1. Press 🖲 to enter the main menu of the TM80.
- 2. Tap **Wireless Modules** \rightarrow from the devices ist select the device you wish to disconnect \rightarrow tap **Disconnect**, or
- 2. Tap Wireless Modules \rightarrow tap MPAN \rightarrow select Off.

Unpairing via the BP10

- 1. Press the MPAN key on the right panel of the BP10.
- 2. Select **Yes** when the prompt message "Are you sure you want to close MPAN and unpair BP10?" appears.

CAUTION:

Before pairing a BP10 with a new TM80, unpair it with the current TM80

first.

Before moving a TM80 or BP10 to another area, unpair them first.

Before admitting a new patient at a BP10, you need to unpair it with the TM80 first.

Discharging a Patient

Tap the Discharge Patient quick key. Or,

Press O to enter the main menu \rightarrow tap **Discharge Patient**.

Alarms

Alarm Status Symbols

Symbol	Description
×	All the alarms are paused.
\mathbf{X}	Audible alarm tones are turned off.

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Symbol Description



Alarms are acknowledged and the alarm system is reset.

Changing Parameter Alarm Properties

1. Enter the **Alarm Limits** menu in either of the following ways:

- Select the Alarm Limits quick key.
- Press \bigcirc to enter the main menu \rightarrow tap **Alarms** \rightarrow tap **Alarm Limits**.
- 2. Tap a parameter and set its alarm properties.

Changing Arrhythmia Alarm Settings

1. Enter the **Arrhythmia Alarm Setup** menu in either of the following ways:

- Tap the Arrhythmia Alarm Setup quick key, if it is configured in the quick key area.
- Press to enter the main menu → tap Alarms → tap Arrhythmia Alarm Setup.
- 2. Tap a parameter and set its alarm properties.

Pausing Alarms

Tap the Alarm Pause quick key. Or,

Press O to enter the main menu \rightarrow from the **Commands** section tap **Alarm Pause**.

Resetting Alarms

Tap the Alarm Reset quick key. Or,

Press O to enter the main menu \rightarrow from the **Commands** section tap **Alarm Reset**.

Unlocking the Screen

- 1. If the display is off, press (a) or (b) to activate the display and access the **Screen Locked** menu.
- 2. Enter the passcode to unlock the screen.

Adjusting Volumes

- 1. Press 🖲 to enter the main menu.
- 2. Tap Audio Volume.
- 3. Select the category to adjust and drag the slider to the appropriate volume.

Review

Reviewing Events

Tap the Events quick key. Or,

Press \bigcirc to enter the main menu \rightarrow tap **Review** \rightarrow tap **Events**.

Reviewing Tabular Trends

On the event review page tab Tabular Trends. Or,

Press \bigcirc to enter the main menu \rightarrow tap **Review** \rightarrow tap **Tabular Trends**.

Entering/Exiting Standby Mode

Entering Standby Mode

1. Enter the standby dialog in either of the following ways:

- Tap the **Standby** quick key, if it is configured in the quick keys area.
- Press \bigcirc to enter the main menu \rightarrow tap **Standby**.

2. Tap **Yes**.

Exiting Standby Mode

Press **•** to exit standby mode.

Entering/Exiting Monitor Mode

Entering Monitor Mode

Tap the **Monitor Mode** quick key. Then, the TM80's display is always on and alarms are issued locally.

Exiting Monitor Mode

Tap the **Telemetry Mode** quick key.
