Minimum System Requirements

To view the training program you must have one of the following browsers or mobile apps:

Windows: Internet Explorer 11, Microsoft Edge (latest version), Google Chrome (latest version) or Firefox (latest version).

Mac: Safari (latest version), Google Chrome (latest version) or Firefox (latest version).

Mobile units: Safari in Apple iOS/iPadOS (latest version), Google Chrome (latest version) in Apple iOS/iPad OS (latest version), Google Chrome (latest version) in Android OS 6 or later.

Required browser settings for viewing courses:

- JavaScript: JavaScript must be enabled for courses to work.
- Font Downloads: Font downloads must be enabled to see the correct fonts and characters.
- No Compatibility View: When using Internet Explorer, turn off Compatibility View for sites where the courses are hosted.

Installing and using the Interactive course

To install the Interactive course on a Web server

If you don't need to track course completion for the users, then web publishing is a good option. Do the following:

1. Use a FTP client to upload the files in the Web folder to a web server. If you're using a web hosting service, they may also have a built-in feature for uploading content.
2. Provide users with the URL for the *story.html* file.

To install the Interactive course on a Learning Management System (LMS)

If you want to track course completion for the users, then you will have to use a LMS to distribute the Interactive course:

1. Upload the zip file in the SCORM 1.2 folder or the SCORM 2004 folder (depending on which SCORM- versions your LMS supports) to the LMS.
2. Provide users with the URL for your course.
